

- 28 (2) The division may not issue a license certificate to a person:
- 29 (a) whose license has been suspended, denied, cancelled, or disqualified during the period
- 30 of suspension, denial, cancellation, or disqualification;
- 31 (b) whose privilege has been revoked, except as provided in Section 53-3-225;
- 32 (c) who has previously been adjudged mentally incompetent and who has not at the time
- 33 of application been restored to competency as provided by law;
- 34 (d) who is required by this chapter to take an examination unless the person successfully
- 35 passes the examination; or
- 36 (e) whose driving privileges have been denied or suspended under:
- 37 (i) Section 78-3a-506 by an order of the juvenile court; or
- 38 (ii) Section 53-3-231.
- 39 (3) The division may grant a class D or M license to a person whose commercial license
- 40 is disqualified under Part 4 of this chapter if the person is not otherwise sanctioned under this
- 41 chapter.
