6 **This act modifies the Medical Examiner Act. The act modifies the duties of the medical**
7 **examiner during a period around the 2002 Olympic Winter Games. The act is repealed on**
8 **April 1, 2002.**

9 This act affects sections of Utah Code Annotated 1953 as follows:

10 ENACTS:

11 **26-4-7.1**, Utah Code Annotated 1953

12 **63-55b-126**, Utah Code Annotated 1953

13 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

14 Section 1. Section **26-4-7.1** is enacted to read:

15 **26-4-7.1. Medical examiner jurisdiction over highway accidents during Olympics.**

16 Notwithstanding Section 26-4-7, between January 25, 2002 and April 1, 2002, the Olympic
17 law enforcement commander, appointed under Section 53-12-301, or the commander's designee,
18 may request that the medical examiner assume custody of a deceased body if it appears that death
19 was caused by a highway accident.

20 Section 2. Section **63-55b-126** is enacted to read:

21 **63-55b-126. Repeal dates -- Title 26.**

22 Section 26-4-7.1 is repealed April 1, 2002.
