At 2:00 p.m. the Committee met on the Capitol steps for departure on a tour of the Olympic Sports Park in Park City.

John Bryan, DBED Office of Procurement Technical Assistance, was the tour guide. While traveling to Park City, Mr. Bryan reviewed the Olympic Venues in Weber, Salt Lake, Utah, Summit, and Wasatch counties.
