H.B. 30 VEHICLE TOWING AND REPORTING REQUIREMENTS

1. Page 7, Line 190: After "motor" delete "or" and insert "and"
2. Page 7, Line 201: Delete "or" and insert "and"
3. Page 7, Line 205: After "owner" insert ", lien holder,"
