Chair Bramble called the meeting to order at 8:41 a.m.

MOTION: Sen. Valentine moved to approve the minutes of January 18, 2001.

The motion passed.

1. S.B. 22 Navajo Nation - Motor and Special Fuel Taxes (M. Dmitrich)

Sen. Dmitrich presented S.B. 22 to the committee.

Speaking to the bill: Linda Hull, Director of Government Affairs, UDOT, Steve Barth, Lobbyist.

MOTION: Sen. Dmitrich moved that the committee hold the bill until further information is available to the Senators.

Sen. Stephenson asked if anyone had come a distance to speak on this bill, before ending the discussion.

The motion passed unanimously.

2. S.B. 27 Sales and Use Tax Exemption for Mining Establishments (*H. Stephenson*)

MOTION: Sen. Stephenson moved to adopt 1st Sub. S.B. 27.

The motion passed with Sen. Allen voting in opposition.

Speaking to the Bill: Rebecca Rochwell, Office of Legislative Research & General Counsel, clarified the changes on Sub 27.

Chair Bramble had a question as to whether Sub 27 included a tax credit for leased equipment.

Rebecca Rochwell acknowledged that the current draft of Sub 27 does not.

MOTION: Sen. Stephenson made the motion that Sub 27 be amended to include leased equipment.

Sen. Valentine suggested the bill be held and amended by the committee.

The motion passed unanimously.
