- 29       (d) draft and designate a ballot title that summarizes the subject matter of the amendment
- 30 or question; and
- 31       (e) deliver them to the lieutenant governor.
- 32       (4) The lieutenant governor shall certify the number and ballot title of each amendment
- 33 or question to the county clerk of each county no later than the second Friday after the primary
- 34 election.
- 35       (5) The county clerk of each county shall:
- 36       (a) ensure that both the number and title of the amendment, question, or referendum is
- 37 printed on the sample ballots and official ballots; and
- 38       (b) publish them as provided by law.
