S.B. 97 Forensic Mental Health Coordinating Council (*K. Hale*)

Senator Hale explained the bill to the committee with the assistance of Mr. Creighton C. Horton, Attorney General's Office.

MOTION: Representative Saunders moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 40: After semi-colon delete "and" and after line 40 insert the following:
 "(m) the director of the Disability Law Center or the director's appointee; and"

2. Page 2, Line 41: At the beginning of the line delete “(m)” and insert “(n)”
3. Page 2, Line 42: Delete “(l)” and insert “(m)”

The motion passed with Representative Lockhart voting no.

Mr. Ron Gardener, Disability Law Center, and Mr. Jesse Gallegos, Deputy Director - Utah Department of Corrections, spoke in support of the bill.

MOTION: Representative Arent moved to pass the bill out favorably.
