MOTION: Rep. Parker moved to approve the minutes of the January 31, 2002 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Aagard and Rep. Bourdeaux absent for the vote.

H.B. 143 Restrictions on Sexually Explicit Email (*B. Winn*)
