

28 individual employed by the school district or volunteering as a participant in a school activity;

29 (ii) causes or attempts to cause a disruption or an annoyance to any passenger on the

30 bus; or

31 (iii) is reckless as to whether the person's presence or behavior will cause fear on the

32 part of any passenger on the bus.

33 (3) Each school district shall ensure that clearly legible signs be placed on each school

34 bus, next to each entrance to the bus, warning that unauthorized entry of a school bus is a

35 violation of state law.
