29 established under Subsection (3).

30 (3) In accordance with Title 63, Chapter 46a, Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, the  
31 Department of Transportation, after consultation with local authorities and school boards which  
32 may include input from School Traffic Safety Committees established under Section  
33 53A-3-402, shall make rules establishing specifications for uniform signage or markings to  
34 clearly identify school bus parking zones.

35 (4) A person may not stop, stand, or park a vehicle other than a school bus, whether  
36 occupied or not, in a clearly identified school bus parking zone.

37 (5) A person who violates Subsection (4) shall pay a minimum fine of [~~\$50~~] \$100.
