**1<sup>st</sup> Sub. H.B. 113 Insurance Coverage for Unique Medical Services (R. Lockhart)**

**H.B. 249     Licensing Mortgage Loan Officers (*B. Parker*)**

MOTION:     Rep. Parker moved to delete in title and body **H.B. 249** and replace it with **1<sup>st</sup> Sub. H.B. 249**. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Buttars absent for the vote.

MOTION:     Rep. Parker moved to amend the bill as follows:

1.     Page 9, Line 267:                     After "~~(C)~~" delete "except as provided in Subsection (4)(a)(ii)."
  
2.     Pages 9-10, Lines 270-274:         Delete lines 270-274 and insert:  
  "(ii) If an individual applying for licensure under Subsection (4)(a)(i) has unsuccessfully attempted to complete the examination approved by the commission under Section 61-2c-104 three times, the individual shall, in addition to the requirements of Subsection (4)(a)(i), provide proof using forms approved by the division of having successfully completed the 45-hour prelicensing course approved by the commission under Section 61-2c-104."

The motion to amend passed unanimously, with Rep. Buttars absent for the vote.

Rep. Parker explained the bill with the assistance of Paul Ray, mortgage lender.
