Vice Chair Aagard called the meeting to order at 8:07 a.m.

**MOTION:** Rep. Morley moved to approve the minutes of the February 10, 2003 meeting. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Bowman, Rep. Jones, Rep. Parker, and Rep. Wallace absent for the vote.

**H.B. 114 Management, Enhancement, and Funding of 911 System (B. Dee)**

**Explained the bill:** Rep. Dee

**MOTION:** Rep. Dee moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 2, Line 39: Delete "14" and insert "15"
2. Page 2, Line 54: After line 54 insert "(ii) a representative from a telephone cooperative having less than 300 subscriber access lines in the state;" renumber the remaining subsections accordingly

The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Jones absent for the vote.
