MOTION: Sen. Jenkins moved to approve the minutes of 1/28/03.

1. S.B. 58 YOUTH CORRECTIONS - DIVISION NAME AMENDMENT (Sen. P. Hellewell)

Sen. Hellewell presented the bill to the committee.

Delpha Baird, former Utah Senator, spoke in favor of the bill and Blake Chard, Division of Youth Corrections, spoke in opposition.

MOTION: Sen. Jenkins moved to pass S.B. 58 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

The motion passed with Sen. J. Evans, Sen. Jenkins, Sen. Thomas and Sen. Julander voting in favor and Sen. Allen and Sen. B. Evans voting against.

2. **H.B. 35 CONSOLIDATION OF CHILD WELFARE (Rep. G. Hughes)**

MOTION: Sen. Evans moved to pass H.B. 35 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

3. **S.B. 121 FEDERAL HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT COMPLIANCE AMENDMENTS**, by Sen. P. Knudson was not discussed.

4. **H. B. 12 UTAH OPTOMETRY PRACTICE ACT AMENDMENTS**, Rep. K. Bryson, was not discussed.

5. **H. B. 36 ACCESSIBLE HOUSING (By Rep. S. Mascaro)**

Rep. Mascaro presented the bill to the committee.

Sen. D. C. Buttars; Joyce Dalcourt, Arc of Utah; and Eileen Glathar, LCPD, spoke in favor of the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Julander moved to pass H. B. 36 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

6. **H.B. 41 LEGISLATIVE BUDGETING FOR COLA FOR LOCAL HEALTH AUTHORITIES (Rep. J. Seitz)**
