**1. S.B. 19 Vehicle History Information (D. Eastman)**

Sen. Eastman presented the bill and proposed the following amendments:

1. Page 1, Line 7: After line 7 insert "**This act allows the department to establish a fee for each vehicle accident history request.**"
2. Page 2, Line 54: After "(i)" insert "any vehicle identifying information that is electronically available, including"
3. Page 2, Line 58: After line 58 insert "(e) The department may establish a fee under Section 63-38-3.2 for the cost of producing and providing vehicle accident history information under Subsection (3)(d)."

**MOTION:** Sen. Steele moved to adopt the amendments.
