26                   **53A-15-1001. Vending machines.**

27                   (1) An elementary school may not sell food of minimal nutritional value, as defined by



28 the United States Department of Agriculture, from a vending machine located in a school area  
29 accessible to students.

30 (2) This section applies to:

31 (a) any vending machine not operated under a contract in effect May 4, 2004; and

32 (b) any vending machine operated under a contract in effect May 4, 2004, upon the  
33 natural expiration or early termination of the contract.
