AMENDS:

4-31-16.5, as enacted by Chapter 290, Laws of Utah 1999

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Section **4-31-16.5** is amended to read:

4-31-16.5. Brucellosis -- Vaccination required for certain cattle -- Testing required to import certain cattle.

(1) As used in this section, "test-eligible" has the meaning defined in 9 C.F.R. Sec.

78.1.

28 (a) less than 4 months of age;

29 (b) going directly to slaughter;

30 (c) going to a Qualified Feedlot;

31 (d) going to an approved auction to be vaccinated on arrival; or

32 (e) designated for slaughter only.

33 (3) (a) Instate origin replacement cattle that are kept for breeding stock must be official
34 calfhood vaccinated for Brucellosis.

35 (b) Female cattle from within the state that are not kept for breeding stock will not be
36 required to be vaccinated.

37 ~~[(3)]~~ (4) (a) Test-eligible cattle imported from states designated as brucellosis-free
38 under 9 C.F.R. Sec. 78.43, that are acquired directly from the farm of origin are not required to
39 be tested for brucellosis before movement into the state.

40 (b) Test-eligible cattle imported from states designated as brucellosis-free under 9
41 C.F.R. Sec. 78.43, that are acquired through trading channels must test negative for brucellosis
42 within 30 days before movement into the state.

43 ~~[(4)]~~ (5) Test-eligible cattle imported from states that have not been designated as
44 brucellosis-free under 9 C.F.R. Sec. 78.43, must test negative for brucellosis within 30 days
45 before movement into the state.

46 ~~[(5)]~~ (6) The department shall make rules in accordance with Title 63, Chapter 46a,
47 Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, to implement this section.
