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24 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

25                   Section 1. Section **9-2-2003** is amended to read:

26                   **9-2-2003. Creation of development zones.**

27                   The department, with approval by the board, may create an Aerospace and Aviation



28 Development Zone at or around any airport in the state that § [f] satisfies the following  
 29 requirements: (1) the airport shall have [j] [~~an instrumental landing system~~] INSTRUMENT  
 29a APPROACH CAPABILITIES ; § (2) ~~the airport shall~~  
 30 ~~have a manned air traffic control tower; (3) the airport shall have~~ § AND (2) THE AIRPORT § has  
 30a land available for  
 31 commercial development on, or contiguous to, the airport[; and (4) ~~Subsections (1) and (2)~~  
 32 ~~sunset on January 1, 2006, unless the Legislature determines otherwise].~~
