Mr. Speaker:

The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 206**, CONSTITUTIONAL DEFENSE COUNCIL AMENDMENTS, by Representative M. Noel, with the following amendments:

0. Page 3, Lines 59 through 64:

- 59 (d) (i) Each agenda shall include the following items :
- 60 = ~~[(i)]~~ (A) a financial report ~~[[detailing all of the monies available to the~~
61 ~~council and how those~~
62 ~~monies have been spent]]~~ ; and
- 62 = ~~[(ii)]~~ (B) a litigation report ~~[[by the attorney general or his designee~~
63 ~~detailing the status,~~
64 ~~schedule, timing, and outlook for each case initiated by the council or for which the~~
65 ~~council has~~
66 ~~requested a report]]~~ . =
- 67 (ii) The financial report presented to the council shall detail all of the monies
68 available to the council and how those
69 monies have been spent, excluding monies spent on and available for litigation.
- 70 (iii) The attorney general or his designee shall present the litigation report and detail
71 the legal status,
72 schedule, timing, outlook, and financial status for each case initiated by the council
73 or for which the council has
74 requested a report.
- 75 (iv) Nothing in this Subsection (d) prohibits the council from closing a meeting
76 under Title 52, Chapter 4, Open and Public Meetings, or prohibits the council from
77 complying with Title 63, Chapter 2, Government Records Access and Management
78 Act.
