1. S.B. 42 UTAH EXEMPTION CODE AMENDMENTS (Sen. D. Gladwell)

MOTION: Sen. Blackham moved to pass H.B. 191 out of committee with a favorable recommendation.

3. S.B. 115 SPECIAL ELECTION DATES (Sen. C. Bramble)
