## EXTENSION OF SALES AND USE TAX EXEMPTION FOR STEEL INDUSTRY

Senator **Ed P. Mayne** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 25 through 28:*

25 This bill:

▶ provides intent language that recommends to the Executive Appropriations Committee that the additional sales and use tax generated by the sunset of the sales and use tax exemption for sales or leases of rolls, rollers, refractory brick, electric motors, or other replacements parts used in the furnaces, mills, or ovens of certain steel mills be used for certain purposes.

2. *Page 9, Lines 267 through 271:*

267 (30) (a) beginning on July 1, 1999, through June 30, ~~[[+]]~~ 2004 ~~[[+]]~~ ~~[[2014]]~~, sales or  
leaves of rolls,

268 rollers, refractory brick, electric motors, or other replacement parts used in the furnaces, mills,

269 or ovens of a steel mill described in SIC Code 3312 of the 1987 Standard Industrial

270 Classification Manual of the federal Executive Office of the President, Office of Management

271 and Budget; and

(b) it is the intent of the Legislature to recommend to the Executive Appropriations Committee that the additional sales and use tax generated by the sunset of the exemption in Subsection (30)(i) be used to fund the waiting list for persons with disabilities;
