

S.B. 115
SPECIAL ELECTION DATES

Representative **David L. Hogue** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 5, Line 145 through Page 6, Line 153:

145 (c) (i) Notwithstanding the requirements of Subsection (1)(b), the legislative body of a
146 local political subdivision may call a local special election on a date other than those specified
147 in this section if :

(A) the legislative body:

148 ~~[(A)]~~ (I) determines and declares that there is ~~[an emergency]~~ a disaster, as defined in
149 Section 63-5-2, requiring that a special election be held on a date other than the ones
150 authorized in statute;

151 ~~[(B)]~~ (II) identifies specifically the nature of the ~~[emergency]~~ disaster, as defined in Section
152 63-5-2, and the reasons for holding the special election on that other date; and

153 ~~[(C)]~~ (III) votes unanimously to hold the special election on that other date ~~[-]~~ ; or

(B) (I) the local special election is for a referendum; and
(II) the subject of the referendum is a land use law as defined in Section 20A-7-601.
