LICENSE AND CERTIFICATION EXTENSION FOR DEPLOYED NATIONAL GUARD MEMBERS

Senator **Peter C. Knudson** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 8 through 17:*

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill extends the licenses or a certification of active members of the National
10 Guard and members of a reserve component of the armed forces .

11 **Highlighted Provisions:**

12 This bill:

- 13 ▶ allows for a 90-day extension for certain licenses or a certification that expire while
14 the National Guard member or reservist is on active duty; and
15 ▶ exempts the National Guard member or reservist from meeting any continuing education or
16 training requirements to obtain a renewal of a license that expired while the member
17 of the National Guard or reservist was on active duty.

2. *Page 2, Lines 33 through 46*

Senate Committee Amendments

2-12-2004:

33 (2) Any license held by a member of the National Guard or reserve component of the armed
34 forces that expires while the member
35 is on active duty shall be extended until 90 days after the member is discharged from active
36 duty status.

37 (3) The licensing agency shall renew a license extended under Subsection (2) until the
38 next date that the license expires or for the period that the license is normally issued, at no cost
39 to the member of the National Guard or reserve component of the armed forces if all of the following
40 conditions are met:

41 (a) the National Guard member or reservist requests renewal of the license within 90 days after
42 being discharged;

43 (b) the National Guard member or reservist provides the licensing agency with a copy of the
44 member's or reservist's official orders calling the member or reservist to active duty, and official
45 orders discharging the
46 member or reservist from active duty; and

47 (c) the National Guard member or reservist meets all the requirements necessary for the renewal of
48 the license, except the member or reservist need not meet the requirements, if any, that relate to

continuing

46 education or training.

(4) The provisions of this section do not apply to regularly scheduled annual training.
