7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill appropriates \$152,000 ongoing from the General Fund beginning in fiscal year
10 2004-05 to the Department of Natural Resources for security at Range Creek and
11 adjusts appropriations to the University of Utah Museum of Natural History for Range
12 Creek.

13 **Highlighted Provisions:**

14 This bill:

15 ▶ redirects \$152,000 in ongoing monies appropriated to the University of Utah for
16 Range Creek to the Department of Natural Resources for security at Range Creek;

17 and

18 ▶ appropriates \$77,000 in one-time monies from the General Fund to the University
19 of Utah Museum of Natural History for Range Creek projects.

20 **Monies Appropriated in this Bill:**

21 ▶ Beginning in fiscal year 2004-05, an ongoing appropriation of \$152,000 is
22 appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Natural Resources for
23 security at Range Creek.

24 ▶ For fiscal year 2004-05, \$77,000 in one-time monies are appropriated to the
25 University of Utah Museum of Natural History and the 2004-05 ongoing
26 appropriation to the University of Utah Museum of Natural History is reduced
27 by \$152,000.



28 **Other Special Clauses:**

29 This bill provides an immediate effective date.

36 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

37 Section 1. **General provisions.**

38 Under the terms and conditions of Section 63-38-3, the following sums of money
39 are appropriated from the funds or fund accounts indicated for the use and support of the
40 government of the state for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2004 and ending June 30, 2005.

41 Section 2. **Item 133, Chapter 256, Laws of Utah 2004** is amended to read:

54 Section 4. **Effective date.**

55 If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect
56 upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah
57 Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto,
58 the date of veto override.
