7 **LONG TITLE**

8 **General Description:**

9 This bill provides for the allocation of trust lands revenue designated for the benefit of
10 the state's normal schools.

11 **Highlighted Provisions:**

12 This bill:

13 ▶ requires that trust lands revenues distributed for the benefit of the state's normal
14 schools shall be allocated to ~~H→~~ [colleges of education] institutions ~~←H~~ within the state system
14a of higher
15 education in proportion to the number of bachelor's degrees awarded by ~~H→~~ [the colleges
16 of education] those insitutions ~~←H~~ in the previous fiscal year.

20 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.

25 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

26 Section 1. Section **53C-3-105** is enacted to read:

27 **53C-3-105.** **Disposition of revenue for normal schools.**



28 Money distributed for the benefit of the state's normal schools, as provided under the
 29 Utah Enabling Act, § Section 12, § Utah Constitution Article X, Section 7, Utah Constitution
 29a Article XX,
 30 Section 2, and Sections 53C-3-101 and 53C-3-103, shall be allocated to ~~H~~→ [the colleges of
 31 education] institutions ←~~H~~ within the state system of higher education, as defined in
 31a Section 53B-1-102, ~~H~~→ that offer bachelor's degrees in education ←~~H~~ in
 32 proportion to the number of bachelor's degrees awarded by ~~H~~→ [the colleges of education] those
 32a institutions ←~~H~~ in the
 33 previous fiscal year.
 34 Section 2. **Effective date.**
 35 This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.
