Mr. Speaker:

The Judiciary Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 131**, ACCESS TO HEALTH CARE FACILITIES AND PLACES OF WORSHIP, by Representative D. Aagard, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 47 through 54:*

- 47 (2) (a) A person is guilty of preventing or impeding passage to a health care facility
48 or
48 place of worship if the person **intentionally or** knowingly obstructs, detains, hinders,
49 impedes, or blocks
49 another person's entry to or exit from the health care facility or place of worship.
50 (b) A person who violates Subsection (2)(a) is guilty of a class B misdemeanor.
51 (3) (a) A person is guilty of unlawfully interfering with passage to a health care
52 facility
52 or place of worship if, within a radius of 100 feet from any entrance door to a health care
53 facility or place of worship, the person **intentionally or** knowingly approaches within
54 eight feet of another
