Mr. Speaker:

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee recommends **H.B. 182**, HISTORICAL LIVESTOCK TRAILS, by Representative B. Johnson, be replaced and reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 182**, HISTORICAL LIVESTOCK TRAILS with the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Lines 40 through 46:

- 40 (3) Notwithstanding Subsections (1) and (2), the owner of any neat cattle, horse, ass,
41 mule, sheep, goat, or swine that trespasses upon the premises of another person is not
 liable in
42 a civil action to the owner or occupant of the premises for damage inflicted by the
 trespass if:
43 (a) the animal enters the premises from an historic livestock trail, as defined in
 Section
44 57-13b-102; and
45 (b) the premises that was trespassed is not enclosed by ~~{a}~~ an adequate
 fence at the time the trespass
46 occurs.
