The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 182**, VETERINARY PRACTICE ACT - EXEMPTIONS, by Senator M. Dmitrich, with the following amendments:

1. Page 2, Line 58 through Page 3, Line 59:

58 (10) any person performing or teaching nonsurgical bovine ~~{or equine}~~ artificial
59 insemination;

2. Page 3, Lines 60 through 64

60 (11) any person affiliated with an institution of higher education who teaches
61 nonsurgical bovine or equine embryo transfer or any technician trained by or
approved by an institution
62 of higher education who performs nonsurgical bovine or equine embryo transfer, but
only if any
63 prescription drug used in the procedure is prescribed and administered under the direction
of a
64 veterinarian licensed to practice in Utah; and
