Mr. President:

The Revenue and Taxation Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **S.B. 227**, PUBLIC SAFETY DRIVING PRIVILEGE AND IDENTIFICATION CARD AMENDMENTS, by Senator C. Bramble, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 41 through 42:*

41 Other Special Clauses:

42 { ~~This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.~~ }

This bill provides an immediate effective date.

2. *Page 8, Lines 231 through 234:*

231 (ii) The receipt serves as a temporary license certificate or temporary driving
privilege card

232 allowing ~~him~~ the person to drive a motor vehicle while the division is completing its

233 investigation to determine whether ~~he~~ the person is entitled to be ~~licensed~~ granted a
driving

234 privilege.

3. *Page 9, Lines 262 through 264:*

262 ~~(5)~~ (8) The division shall issue temporary license certificates or

temporary driving privilege

4. *Page 11, Lines 333 through 334:*

333 Section 5. Effective date.

334 { ~~This bill takes effect on July 1, 2005.~~ }

If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect upon approval by the governor, or the day following the constitutional time limit of Utah Constitution Article VII, Section 8, without the governor's signature, or in the case of a veto, the date of veto override.
