S.J.R. 14 Joint Resolution on Stroke Awareness (Sen. P. Knudson)

Rep. Menlove presented S.J.R. 14 to the committee.

S.B. 206 Nonparticipating Tobacco Manufacturer Amendments (Sen. S. Killpack)

1. Page 16, Lines 468 through 476:

reporting period;
