Rep. Barrus called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m.

Rep. Barrus called for an introduction of the committee members.

H.B. 177 Wildlife License Refund Amendments (Rep. M. Dayton)

Rep. Dayton explained the bill with the assistance of Miles Moretti, Director, Division of Wildlife Resources.

Spoke for the bill: Gregory Sheehan, Division of Wildlife Resources

MOTION: Rep. Gowans moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously.

H.B. 181 Duplicate Wildlife Licensing Amendments (Rep. M. Dayton)

Rep. Dayton explained the bill with the assistance of Miles Moretti, Director, Utah Wildlife Resources.

Rep. Dayton moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. *Page 1, Line 26 through Page 2, Line 31:*

- 26 ~~[Whenever any]~~ If an unexpired license, permit, tag, or certificate of registration
issued
27 under the provisions of this code is destroyed, lost, or stolen, the Division of Wildlife
28 Resources and its authorized license agents may ~~{set fees and}~~ issue a
duplicate license [~~at a fee to be determined by the Wildlife~~
29 ~~Board. To obtain the duplicate license~~], permit, tag, or certificate of registration [~~the~~
~~applicant~~
30 ~~must complete an affidavit testifying to such loss, destruction or theft, and provide such~~

the Wildlife Board.
