1. H.B. 24 Traffic Code Amendments (J. Dunnigan)

MOTION: Sen. Walker moved to adopt **1st Sub. S.B. 24**.

The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Bramble and Sen. Mayne absent for the vote.

Rep. Dunnigan explained the bill.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to pass **1st Sub. S.B. 24** out favorably.

2. H.B. 48 Motor Vehicle Registration and Safety Inspection Amendments (B. Daw)
