Chair Wallace called the meeting to order at 2:19 p.m. and welcomed committee members. A Priority List for the Departments of Commerce & Revenue was distributed to the committee for prioritization.

MOTION: Rep. Frank moved to approve the minutes of February 2 & 3, 2005. The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Bramble absent for the vote.

MOTION: Rep. Dunnigan moved to change the **Insurance** priority list item, HIP Utah, as follows:
Line 4.- HIP Utah (\$2,796,100 ongoing, \$8,203,900 1X) \$11,000,000 from the General Fund.
Line 5.- delete HIP Utah One- time Funding \$1,000,000 from the General Fund.

MOTION: Sen. Madsen moved to amend Rep. Dunnigan's motion. Consolidate Lines 4 & 5 HIP Utah, from the **Insurance** Department to equal \$8,203,900 and reduce the priority items to 3.

Rep. Dunnigan requested the motion be divided. The motion failed in the Senate with Senators Bramble and Madsen and Representatives Frank and Romero voting in opposition.

MOTION: Sen. Madsen moved to vote on the Commerce & Revenue priority items one Department at a time. The motion passed unanimously.

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MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to approve the priorities for **Alcoholic Beverage Control**. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to approve the priorities for **Financial Institutions**. The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Madsen moved to change from the **Labor Commission** priority list:
Line 5.- UOSH Safety & Health Officer (\$33,500 fed. match) from GFR-
Workplace Safety to General Fund.
Line 6.- Work Place Safety Media & Grants to Work Place Safety.
Line 7.- Work Place Safety Media & Grants Supp. to Work Place Safety Supp.
Line 8.- delete Attorney General Assessment of \$47,200 GFR-Workplace Safety.

Sen. Bramble called for a division on the vote.

Line 5.- UOSH Safety & Health Officer (\$33,500 fed. match) from GFR-Work
Place Safety to General Fund, *as long as the Federal Funds are available and
matched*.

The motion passed unanimously.

Line 6.- Work Place Safety Media & Grants to Work Place Safety

Line 7.- Work Place Safety Media & Grants Supp. to Work Place Safety Supp.

Line 8.- delete Attorney General Assessment of \$47,200 GFR- Workplace Safety.

The motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Mayne moved to approve \$608,200 from Alcoholic Beverage Enf. & Treat.
Fund for Liquor Profit Distribution for the **Tax Commission Department**. The
motion passed unanimously.

MOTION: Sen. Bramble moved to add \$108,000 from Commerce Service Fund for a Fiscal
note in Real Estate and approve \$45,000 from Commerce Service Fund for
Pawnshop fee spending authority in the **Commerce Department**. The motion
passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rep. Frank moved to approve the Base Budgets, Fees, Intent Language and
Federal Funds for **all Departments of Commerce & Revenue**. The motion
passed unanimously.

MOTION: Rep. Frank, who is noted in the minutes to be "on time" for the meeting, moved to
adjourn. The motion passed unanimously. Chair Wallace adjourned the meeting
at 3:17 p.m.
