LONG TITLE

General Description:

This bill requires the Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee to study certain issues relating to school nurses.

- requires a final report to be prepared prior to the 2007 General Session of the Legislature.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. **Study -- Final report.**



26 (1) The Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee shall review and make
27 recommendations on the following issues:

28 (a) public education school nurse staffing issues, including nurse-student ratios;

29 (b) best practices to improve school nurse services in public education;

30 (c) the funding of school nurses;

31 (d) health clinic requirements under the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001, 20 U.S.C.

32 Sec. 6301 et seq.:

33 (e) the coordination between public health nurses and school nurses; and

34 (f) the use of licensed, volunteer school nurses.

35 (2) The Public Education Appropriations Subcommittee shall prepare a final report on
36 the issues described under Subsection (1) prior to the 2007 General Session of the Legislature.

37 Section 2. **Repeal date.**

38 This bill is repealed on January 15, 2007.
