



- 28           (a) a stay of execution has not been granted;
- 29           (b) the requirements of this chapter are satisfied; and
- 30           (c) the judgment is recorded in the office of the county recorder where the property of
- 31 the judgment debtor is located, as provided in Section 78-22-1.
- 32           (2) The lien becomes effective at the time and date of recording and expires eight years
- 33 after date of entry by the court in the foreign jurisdiction unless renewed in Utah as required by
- 34 Utah law.
