**H.B. 286 Mold Amendments (*Rep. D. Hogue*)**

**1st Sub. H.B. 286**

**MOTION:** Rep. Kiser moved to delete in title and body H.B. 286 and replace it with 1st Substitute H.B. 286. The motion passed unanimously, with Rep. Adams, Rep. S. Clark, Rep. Hansen, and Rep. Morley absent for the vote.
