**S.B. 66 Price Controls During Emergencies Amendments (*Sen. P. Arent*)**

Sen. Arent explained the bill to the committee, with the assistance of Thad LeVar, Director, Division of Consumer Protection and Jim Olsen, Utah Retail Merchants Association.

**H.B. 138 Mercury Switch Removal Act (*Rep. R. Menlove*)**
