MOTION: Rep. Jones moved to approve the minutes of the January 27, 2006 meeting. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Buxton, Rep. Litvack, and Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

H.B. 130 Adoption Amendments (Rep. A. Hardy)

Rep. Hardy introduced H.B. 130 and explained it to the committee, assisted by Larry Jenkins, Utah Adoption Council.

MOTION: Rep. Jones moved to pass the bill out favorably. The motion passed unanimously with Rep. Menlove absent for the vote.

H.B. 137 Medication Aide Certified (Rep. R. Lockhart)

MOTION: Rep. Lockhart moved to amend the bill as follows:

1. Page 15, Lines 442 through 445:

- 442 (8) For purposes of this section and Section 58-31b-402[;];
443 (a) "licensed" or "license" includes "certified" or "certification" under this chapter[;];
444 and
445 (b) any terms or conditions applied to the word "nurse" in this section or
Section 58-31b-402 also apply to ~~{includes}~~ a medication aide certified.

2. *Page 16, Lines 462 through 464:*

462 (2) (a) using any other name, title, or initials that would cause a reasonable
person to

463 believe the user is licensed or certified under this chapter if the user is not properly
licensed or

464 certified under this chapter; and =

**(b) for purposes of Subsection (2)(a), it is unlawful conduct for a medication aide
certified to use the term "nurse"; and**
