**MOTION:** Sen. Thomas moved to approve the minutes of the meetings held January 27 and January 31. The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Dmitrich, Madsen and Hillyard absent for the vote.

**1. S.B. 173 Licensure of Programs and Facilities - Criminal Background Check Amendments** (*T. Hatch*)

Sen. Hatch presented the bill. Ken Stettler, Department of Human Services, Office of Licensing, assisted in the presentation.

Fraser Nelson, Disability Law Center, spoke to the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Mansell moved to pass S.B. 173 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously.

**2. S.B. 135 Inherent Risk of Skiing Amendments (L. Hillyard)**

Sen. Hillyard presented the bill. Gordon Strachen, Utah Ski Association, and Bob Bonar, Snowbird, assisted in the presentation.

Roger Hoole, Utah Trial Lawyers Association, expressed a concern with the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Arent moved to pass S.B. 135 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously with Sen. Mansell absent for the vote.

**3. S.B. 181 Restoration of Felon's Right to Hold Office (P. Hellewell)**

Sen. Hellewell presented the bill.

**MOTION:** Sen. Thomas moved to pass S.B. 181 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Hillyard and Mansell absent for the vote.

**4. S.B. 52 Antiphishing Provisions (P. Arent)**

Sen. Arent presented the bill. Creighton Horton and Rich Hamp, Attorney General's Office, assisted in the presentation.

**MOTION:** Sen. Dmitrich moved to pass S.B. 52 out of committee with a favorable recommendation. The motion passed unanimously with Sens. Hillyard and Mansell absent for the vote.
