Representative **Douglas C. Aagard** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 12 through 13:*

12 ▶ increases from 1,000 to ~~{2,000}~~ 1,250 the maximum number of active voters allowed for
 a
13 voting precinct;

2. *Page 1, Lines 22 through 23:*

22 for each of the combined precincts are identical; ~~{-and-}~~ =
 ▶ requires each county to have at least two polling places in the county on the date of the election;
 ▶ requires each common polling place to have at least one voting device that is accessible for individuals with disabilities; and
23 ▶ makes technical changes.

3. *Page 3, Lines 68 through 70:*

68 (c) A county may use one set of election judges for the [~~combined precincts if the~~
69 ~~ballots for each of the combined precincts are identical~~] common polling place under this
70 Subsection (4). =
 (5) Each county shall have at least two polling places open for voting on the date of the election.
 (6) Each common polling place shall have at least one voting device that is accessible for individuals with disabilities in accordance with Public Law 107-252, the Help America Vote Act of 2002.
