Senator **Carlene M. Walker** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 13, Lines 372l through 372p*

House Floor Amendments

1-25-2006:

372l (iii) (A) During the period beginning on the day on which a temporary limited
372m driver license is issued under this Subsection (6) and ending on the day that the temporary
372n limited driver license expires, the suspension described in this Subsection (6) only applies if the
372o person who is suspended operates a motor vehicle for a purpose other than employment,
372p education, or child visitation.

(B) Upon expiration of a temporary limited driver license described in this Subsection (6)(d), a suspension described in Subsection (6)(a) shall be in effect, without limitation, until the division receives notice, under Subsection (6)(b), that the order of suspension is rescinded.
