Senator **Lyle W. Hillyard** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 23 through 24:*

23 ▶ describes the circumstances under which a foreign protection order is valid and
24 enforceable in Utah;

 ▶ specifies which court will have jurisdiction to enforce foreign protection orders under this bill;

2. *Page 9, Lines 262 through 266:*

262 (7) A tribunal of this state may enforce provisions of a mutual foreign protection order
263 which favor a respondent only if:

264 (a) the respondent filed a written pleading seeking a protection order from the tribunal
265 of the issuing state; and

266 (b) the tribunal of the issuing state made specific findings in favor of the respondent.

(8) (a) The juvenile court has jurisdiction to enforce foreign protection orders under this section over which the juvenile court would have had jurisdiction if the order had been originally sought in this state.

(b) The district court has jurisdiction to enforce foreign protection orders under this section:
 (i) over which the district court would have had jurisdiction if the order had been originally sought in this state; or

(ii) that are not under the jurisdiction of the juvenile court under Subsection (8)(a).
