## Mr. President:

The Health and Human Services Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **1st Sub. H.B. 242**, MEDICAID FALSE CLAIMS ACT AMENDMENTS, by Representative B. Last, with the following amendments:

- 1. Page 3, Lines 62 through 65:
  - 62 <u>the money or property.</u>
  - [(2)] (3) "False statement" or "false representation" means a wholly or partially untrue
  - 64 statement or representation which is :
    - (a) knowingly [and willfully] made [if the person making the
  - 65 statement or representation has knowledge of the falsity thereof] <u>: and</u>
    (b) a material fact with respect to the claim.
- 2. Page 6, Lines 153 through 154:
  - 153 (1) (a) Except as provided in Subsection (1)(b) the mental state required for a criminal violation of this chapter is
  - knowingly, intentionally, or recklessly as defined in Section 76-2-103.
    - (b) The culpable mental state required for a criminal violation of this chapter for kickbacks and bribes under Section 26-20-4 is knowingly and intentionally as defined in Section 76-2-103.
