The Government Operations Committee reports a favorable recommendation on **H.B. 395**, WAIVERS OF IMMUNITY - EXCEPTIONS, by Representative G. Hughes, with the following amendments:

1. *Page 2, Lines 48 through 55:*

- 48 (c) intentionally or knowingly:
49 (i) fabricated evidence; **or**
50 (ii) with a conscious disregard for the rights of others, failed to disclose
 ~~{ **exculpatory** }~~
51 evidence that:
52 (A) was known to the person, official, or institution; and
53 (B) was known by the person, official, or institution to be relevant to an issue
 or matter
54 of inquiry in a judicial or administrative proceeding { **or**
55 ~~— **(iii) obtained testimony by duress or undue influence** }~~ .

2. *Page 4, Lines 98 through 105:*

- 98 (v) the employee intentionally or knowingly:

100 (B) with a conscious disregard for the rights of others, failed to disclose
