UNIFORM COMMERCIAL CODE - GENERAL PROVISIONS

Senator **Lyle W. Hillyard** proposes the following amendments:

1. *Page 21, Lines 619 through 629:*

- 619 (2) Where one of the following provisions of this title specifies the applicable law, that
