REDUCED CIGARETTE IGNITION PROPENSITY

Representative **Todd E. Kiser** proposes the following amendments:

1. Page 11, Lines 310 through 318:

310 53-7-407. Implementation **- effect of part on Model Tobacco Settlement Act and Tobacco Tax and**
 Licensing Act .

311 (1) The state fire marshal may promulgate rules and regulations, pursuant to Title 63,
312 Chapter {~~46b~~} **46a** . Utah Administrative Rulemaking Act, necessary to effectuate the purposes of this
313 part.

314 (2) The State Tax Commission in the regular course of conducting inspections of
315 wholesale dealers, agents, and retail dealers, as authorized under Title 59, Chapter 14, Cigarette
316 and Tobacco Tax and Licensing Act, may inspect cigarettes to determine if the cigarettes are
317 marked as required by Section 53-7-405. If the cigarettes are not marked as required, the State
318 Tax Commission shall notify the state fire marshal. =

(3) Nothing in this part shall affect an entity's obligations pursuant to:
(a) Title 59, Chapter 14, Cigarette and Tobacco Tax and Licensing Act; or
(b) Title 59, Chapter 22, Model Tobacco Settlement Act.
