LONG TITLE

ENACTS UNCODIFIED MATERIAL

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:

Section 1. Study on public transit.

(1) During the 2008 interim, the Transportation Interim Committee shall study public transit ridership, air quality, and transit fare policies.



- 26 (2) The study required by Subsection (1) shall include a review of:
27 (a) current public transit ridership numbers;
28 (b) policies and strategies to improve public transit ridership throughout the state;
29 (c) policies and strategies to improve the impact of public transit on air quality; and
30 (d) the costs and benefits of reducing or eliminating public transit fares on:
31 (i) yellow air quality action days; and
32 (ii) red air quality alert days.
