renumbered and amended to read:

(1) If the Utah Rules of Criminal Procedure, Civil Procedure, or Evidence require or permit a written declaration upon oath, an individual may, with like force and effect, provide



28 an unsworn written declaration, subscribed and dated under penalty of this section, in  
29 substantially the following form:

30 "I declare (or certify, verify, or state) under criminal penalty of the State of Utah that the  
31 foregoing is true and correct.
