**Committee Note:**

**General Description:**

This bill provides legislative action regarding administrative rules.

**Highlighted Provisions:**

This bill:

- ▶ reauthorizes all state agency administrative rules, except:
  - a rule regarding secure areas at the State Hospital; and
  - a rule regarding the issuing of concealed firearm permits.

**Other Special Clauses:**

This bill takes effect on May 1, 2008.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the state of Utah:*

Section 1. **Rules reauthorized.**

All rules of Utah state agencies are reauthorized, except for the following:

1. R525-6-1, Human Services, Substance Abuse and Mental Health, State Hospital,

Prohibited Items and Devices; and



28           2. R722-300, Public Safety, Criminal Investigations and Technical Services Criminal  
29 Identification, Concealed Firearm Permit Rule.

30           Section 2. **Effective date.**

31           If approved by two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, this bill takes effect  
32 on May 1, 2008.
