29 Section 1. **Appropriation.**

30 For fiscal year 2008-09 only, there is appropriated \$2,000,000 from the General Fund to
31 the Division of Housing and Community Development in the Department of Community and
32 Culture to be granted to the Swanson Foundation to be used exclusively for the Swanson
33 Tactical Training Center.
