Mr. President:

The Natural Resources, Agriculture, and Environment Committee recommends **S.B. 46**, ANTI-FLOW CONTROL AMENDMENTS, by Senator D. Eastman, be replaced and favorably recommends **1st Sub. S.B. 46**, ANTI-FLOW CONTROL AMENDMENTS with the following amendments:

1. *Page 1, Lines 13 through 15:*

13 ▶ prohibits a public entity from requiring solid waste to be stored, recovered, or
14 disposed of at a specific waste facility {~~unless the public entity has physical custody~~
~~15 of the solid waste~~} except in certain circumstances ;

2. *Page 181, Line 181 through Page 7, Line 184:*

181 owned or operated by a public entity if :
 (a) the solid waste is in the physical custody of:
182 ~~{(a)}~~ (i) the public entity; or
183 ~~{(b)}~~ (ii) a person with whom the public entity has an agreement to provide solid
184 waste management ~~{.}~~ ; or
 (b) no other solid waste management facility exists within:
 (i) the county in which the public entity is located; or
